

AYN PRIVACY POLICY

Advance Youth Now (AYN) is a company driven by family values, from our family to yours. We have teenagers ourselves, we take your privacy seriously and are committed to protecting your personal information. In particular, rest assured that your information will remain securely stored in our system, and we do not share your information with anyone. This privacy policy explains in detail what information we collect, how we store it, and how we use it to work with you.

Types of Data We Collect

Cookies

Once you enter our website, we use a standard web data analytics tool that automatically places cookies on your device and collects information such as the number of visitors we get to our website, where they click, and how long they spend on each page. This data does not contain your name or your address, it is anonymised and we cannot identify who you are from this data.

We use cookie data to optimize our website and the content we offer on it. Your web browser should have an option to disable cookies, and an option to delete cookies as soon as you close the browser window.

Mailing lists

As part of the registration process through our website, we collect your name and email address. We use these to send you information about our upcoming events, any free material we may have on offer at the time, and to keep you posted on new products and offers from Advance Youth Now. We would also use it to reply to your queries, to obtain additional information from you if needed in connection to our business with you, and to obtain feedback from you after one of our events.

We use [InfusionSoft](#) (KEAP) for managing our client database. We do not rent, sell or trade lists with other organisations or businesses.

Events information

We use [PayPal](#) and/or [Eventbrite](#) for ticketing of our online and in-person paid events. These third-party providers may ask for your address, payment details and other information which will be subject to their own privacy policies as detailed on their websites. We will not request this information from either PayPal or Eventbrite.

Access to your personal information
